Union Workers to Rally for a Fair Contract at Asarco Headquarters

TUCSON, Az. – The United Steelworkers (USW) today said that on Mon., June 1, workers represented by eight international labor unions will rally for a fair contract at Asarco corporate headquarters.

Although the previous contract expired June 30, 2013, about 2,000 hourly production and maintenance employees at the Grupo Mexico subsidiary's five U.S. locations have been working under an extension subject to a 15 day notice for either side to terminate while negotiations proceed.

The USW represents 850,000 men and women employed in metals, mining, pulp and paper, rubber, chemicals, glass, auto supply and the energy-producing industries, along with a growing number of workers in public sector and service occupations.
